

## First Aid “How To” Video

*Objective: Create a “How To” video on how to treat a specific first aid emergency using Flipgrid*

### Project Steps

Step 1: **Research** information about the first aid emergency your group was assigned. Complete the research worksheet after reading info in the Child Development Binder and online.

Step 2: **Write** a script for your skit. Each group member needs to have a role in the movie (i.e. babysitter, child, parent(s), video recording, 911 operator, etc.). Your scenario is already created; you must decide what each character will be saying/doing during your skit.

#### **Required Skit Information** *(all information from the research worksheet)*

- What is your first aid emergency?
- How did the emergency occur (from scenario card)
- What are the symptoms of the emergency?
- Is this an emergency that requires immediate medical care? Do you need to call 911 or can you handle it yourself? How do you know?
- How do you treat this emergency? If you need to call 911, what can you do while you are waiting to help the patient?

Step 3: **Create** a video of your skit in Flipgrid. Practice your skit a couple of times before the final taping. When you are taping, you should be serious (no laughing/joking around). This is a video teaching someone how to treat a specific first aid emergency.

#### **Flipgrid Directions**

- Open the Flipgrid App
- Enter in Grid code (given by teacher)
- Find and click on the topic that contains your First Aid Emergency
- Click on the green circle with the + to make a new video
- Click on the red circle with the camera inside to begin recording (you have only 1 minute and 30 seconds to record your video-you do not need to use the whole time)
- Click the green circle with arrow when done recording
- Watch your video and make sure you have included all info and that it is loud enough
- Hit the green circle with the arrow to continue; to re-record, hit the red circle with the trash can and record your skit again.
- Take a group selfie (all members included)
- Hit the green circle with the arrow to continue; to re-take a selfie, hit the red circle with the trash can
- Fill in the information (first name-First Aid, last name-Emergency, email address-leave blank, Title-your first aid emergency, link-leave blank), click submit, click return to topic, click on arrow in upper left to return to main screen.

Step 4: **Complete** First Aid Information Worksheet (chart) by watching other groups Flipgrid videos

1. What is your first aid emergency?
2. How did the emergency occur?
3. What are the symptoms of this emergency?
4. Is this an emergency that requires immediate medical care? Do you need to call 911 or can you handle it yourself? How do you know?
5. How do you treat this emergency? If you need to call 911, what can you do while you are waiting to help the patient?
