



Select a picture you would like to sew. Then Print. You MAY send your picture to Mrs. P for printing. It will be in black and white.




Stepa

Tape your picture to the canvas. You can use Mrs. P's tape.





5tep3-IMPORTANT!

What it should look like when you're done making holes.



Using your pin, poke holes along the lines you will sew. MAKE SURE THEY ARE NOT TOO CLOSE AND NOT TOO FAR APART.



Step 4

Use embroidery thread to SEW your design.

Ask Mrs. P for the colors you need. This part can be tricky. DO NOT throw your picture away. You may want it as a reference.


