Creativity A person's level of artistic ability and originality – how artistically talented they are and the extent to which they stray off the beaten path.		
Kindness A person's benevolence or willingness to be helpful to others.		

Characteristic	Allocation of Dollars	Justification Explanation
Humor How funny and witty someone is – their ability to make you laugh or laugh at what you say.		
Religiosity How seriously the person takes religion and their contribution to the religious community.		
Modesty/Morality How open the individual is to prior activity(ies) before marriage such as # of dating partners, reputation, drug use, STI's, etc.)		
Wants children The person's desire to start a family and have children.
