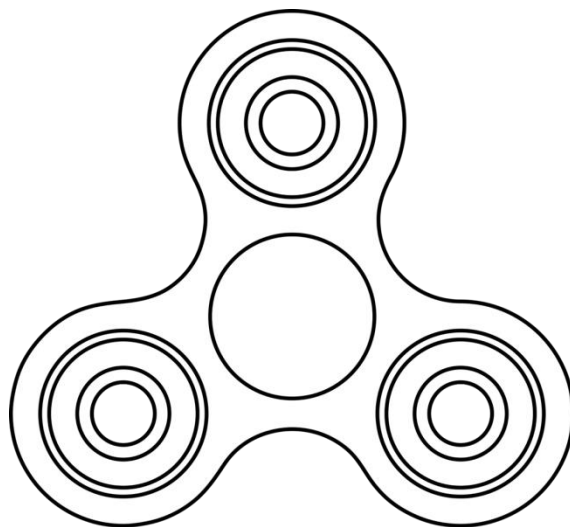

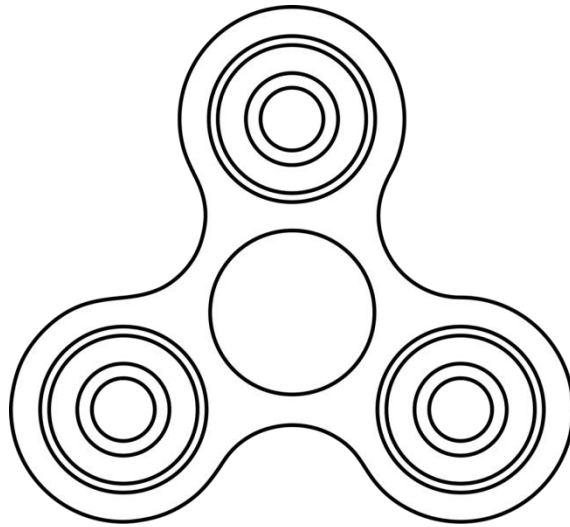

Pack firmly into a dry measuring cup and level off top with straight edge of flat edge.	Spoon into a dry measuring cup until it is overfilled. Level off the top of the measuring cup with a flat edge.
Stir lightly with a fork or spoon. Spoon lightly into dry measuring cup until it is overflowing. Do not shake or tap. Level off the top with a flat edge.	Dip small measuring spoon into container and bring it up heaping full. Level off the top with a flat edge.

Pack firmly into a dry measuring cup and level off the top with a flat edge. Remove with a rubber spatula.

Place measuring cup on a flat surface. Pour into the measuring cup until it reaches the desired level. View at eye level.
