

PART I: CAPSULE **WARDROBE**

Create a 30 piece Capsule Wardrobe that consists of the following:

- 9 tops (shirts, blouses, tanks)
- 3 sweaters or jackets
- 4 dresses
- 6 bottoms (skirts, jeans, shorts, capris, leggings)
- 6 shoes
- 2 accessories (hats, scarves, jewelry)

The [Capsule Planner](#) may be a useful tool to help you figure out your lifestyle, personal style and colors.

Criteria:

- Create the capsule wardrobe using the Polyvore App
- \$300-\$500 Budget
- _____ Season
- Explain why you chose the pieces you did and the process or criteria you used to make your selections. (2 paragraphs minimum made up of 5 sentences each minimum)
- Create a Google Slide Portfolio of your capsule collection from Polyvore, the total amount of money you spent and your written explanations.

PART II: THE **INFOMERCIAL**

Create a short infomercial or trailer for the capsule wardrobe you created to share with the class.

Criteria:

- Promote your personal capsule wardrobe; the entire wardrobe as well as at least 5 combinations of outfits that could be created from it.
- Name your collection like the fashion designers do! Be creative!
- Encourage others to create a capsule wardrobe!
- Must include music
- Must be between 30 and 60 seconds in length

Reflection:

How easy or difficult was it to build a capsule wardrobe from beginning to end on Polyvore?

How easy or difficult would it be to do in your own closet, with the clothing you already own?

Do you think you could realistically minimize your wardrobe for each season into 30 pieces? Explain why or why not?
