

Chopped – Recipe Version

Have you ever watched the TV show *Chopped*? Each contestant is presented with a basket of mystery ingredients they must use to create a meal based on the theme given to them. Their meal is judged based on use of the mystery ingredients, creativity, taste, and presentation. After each round one contestant is chopped (eliminated) from the competition. Often the ingredients in the mystery basket are uncommon or not related to the other ingredients, making it quite a challenge!

You are going to have the opportunity to participate in a similar, but adapted version, challenge in Chopped – Recipe Version. Here is how it will work:

- You will work with the students assigned to your group to complete each challenge
- Your group will be presented with a list of mystery ingredients that must be included in your chosen recipe (all groups will receive the same list of mystery ingredients for each challenge)
- Your group will find a recipe to present to the class that matches the theme, is creative, appealing, and includes all of the ingredients presented to you as mystery ingredients
- You can assume that you also have available for use a common kitchen pantry of ingredients such as flour, sugar, milk, eggs, spices, etc. If you are not sure if an ingredient in your recipe would be provided, check with the teacher for clarification.
- Be sure to be creative and unique when choosing a recipe! If you present the same recipe as another group, you will be eliminated from that challenge.
- Once you choose a recipe, your group will prepare a Google Slide Presentation of your recipe. Your presentation should include:
 - The name of the recipe you chose
 - A hyperlink to the full recipe you chose
 - A picture of the recipe you chose
 - Be prepared to discuss/explain your recipe and how you used the mystery ingredients
- Your classmates will be the judges of the competition. After each group has made their presentation, each student will cast a vote for the recipe they feel meets the criteria the best (creativity, appealing, and best use of mystery ingredients). If there is a tie, in scoring, the teacher will break the tie using the tiebreaker for the challenge – listed with the mystery ingredients.
- Scoring: The group with the highest score for a challenge will be considered the winner and receive a reward. The group receiving the highest score after all challenges are complete will be determined the Chopped – Recipe Champion!
