Literacy 5 Ways

Singing promotes language development & literacy skills such as auditory memory, phonics, and vocabulary.



Not only do puppet shows encourage imagination, but they also promote oral language skills.

Reading pictures and words helps children visual the storyline and builds confidence as they learn to sound out words.



Practicing how to write names and words promotes learning the alphabet, upper and lower case letter discrimination and strengthens fine motor skills.

Show & Tell allows a child to demonstrate speaking and listening skills.
