

Family Function Stations

- Set up 10 stations around the room, each representing a different family function. Items included at the stations are listed below, but substitutions can be made. Most are easily found at Dollar Stores or Walmart.
- Students receive a “ballot” and have 15-20 minutes to rotate through each of the stations, inspecting and interacting with the items.
- The goal is to try to figure out the family function being represented by the station.

Set Up:

Station	Family Function	Items
#1	Recreation	Amusement park tickets, bat & ball, birthday invitation, museum & trip brochure, frisbee and balloons
#2	Adaptation	Play-doh, movable/bendable action figure, rubber band, chewing gum, bendable/moldable ring, yo-yo
#3	Procreation	Congratulation card, ID bracelet, DVD Case of “What to Expect When You’re Expecting”, baby book, pregnancy test (box), ultra-sound photo
#4	Love, Affection, Support	Plastic ears, “I’m Amazing” pin, plastic heart, play cell phone, smiley stickers, bag of Hershey’s Hugs & Kisses”
#5	Religious/Spiritual	Daily devotional, hymn book, church bulletin, Happy Hanakkah card, cross necklace, praying hands
#6	Economic	Sample checks, checkbook & register, piggy bank, credit card sample, fake wallet, play money, stock certificate, budget/receipts
#7	Protection	Lock, thimble, physical and/or immunization form, smoke detector, helmet, knee pads
#8	Education	Chalk, mini chalkboard, college brochure, SAT book, planner, college application, diploma, report card, National Honor Society pin
#9	Socialization	Voter registration card, license, manners/etiquette book, silverware, Got Morals? (mini-poster)
#10	Basic Physical Needs	Play food, empty food boxes, Barbie & Ken clothes & shoes, mini doll house,
