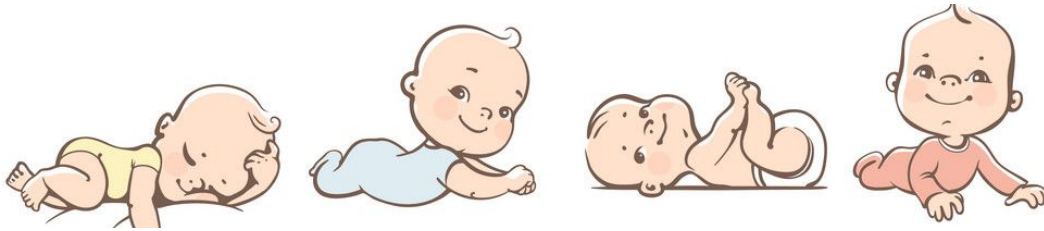


Infants in Motion: Physical Milestones Video Project



Step 1:

Use the “[Monthly Baby Milestone Chart](#)” to fill in the milestone (s) associated with each month of a baby’s development. For month ranges, choose one milestone for one month and two for the other if the required amount is an odd #. If the required amount is an even #, represent each month equally.

Step 2:

Go to Google images and select pictures that represent each of the milestones from the above chart. Save this to your camera roll. Be sure that the age of the infant in the picture matches the age of the milestone!

Step 3:

Using Adobe Spark Video, create a video showing an infant's developmental milestones in motion from their first month until their first birthday. Be sure to identify each month and then lead into the infant's milestone(s). Also, be sure to caption or identify the milestone that is occurring in each picture.

Step 4:

Make sure your video is set to school and theme appropriate music, pleasing paced speed (not too fast or slow) and free of spelling/grammatical errors.

Rubric
