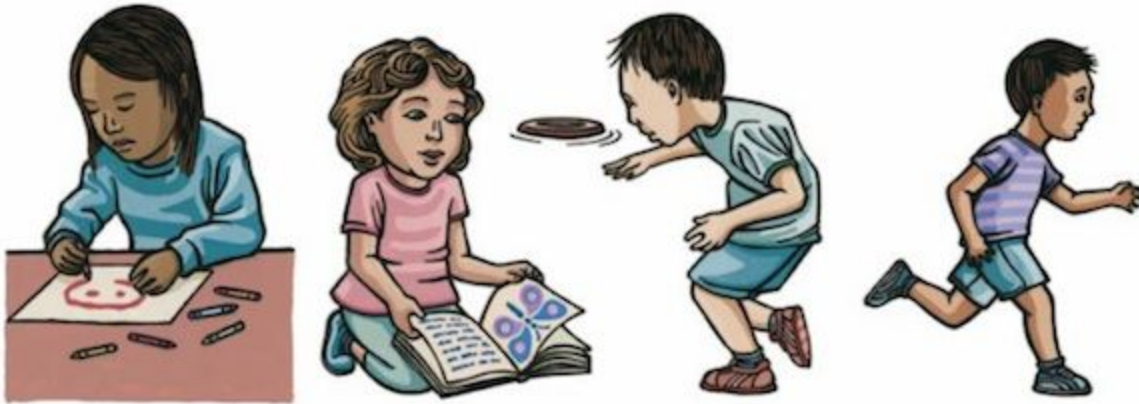


Motor Skill Activities Alphabet Book for Young Children



You and your team have been hired to research fine and gross motor skill activities. Each letter of the alphabet will represent a developmentally appropriate activity geared to children aged 3-5. Each team member will be assigned certain letters of the alphabet. It's up to you to decide which letters will represent fine motor skills and which will represent gross motor skills. All letters and activities will be constructed as an e-book, using the provided template in Google Slides.

****It's up to your team to communicate and collaborate the activities you are using to avoid duplicates within the book. Duplicates will cause a loss of points to the entire team grade so plan as a group! You may use the internet along with Pinterest for ideas...just be sure they are safe with adult supervision and developmentally appropriate!**

Criteria: You must have a title page along with 26 additional pages; one for each letter of the alphabet! Each page must include the following:

- Letter of the Alphabet
- Name of the Activity
- Fine or Gross Skills
- Activity Overview
- Picture of Activity
- Sources Hyperlinked
