

PROJECT MENU FOR IDENTITY THEFT

<p>Create 3-4 Breakout Challenges using digital codes or actual lock boxes with 4 digit combinations. Challenge activities must utilize concepts learned about identity theft incorporating the deter, detect, defend information. Use QR codes to link to online sites and Google Forms or Thinfi to password protect documents used in challenges.</p>	<p>Create a detailed 2 row comic strip (minimum) using “Storyboard That” educating others on the importance of protecting yourself from identity theft. You will need to sign out a chromebook from the library to complete this assignment. **This may be hand generated if you are artistic.</p>	<p>Create/write a children’s book using “Storybird” explaining identity theft to children ages 8-12 and the importance of being protected. Must be at least 10 pages in length,include a cover and original title. See the teacher for a class code. **This may be hand generated if you are artistic.</p>
<p>Create an informative Public Service Announcement or Television Commercial using iMovie on identity theft and the importance of protecting yourself. Must be 1-3 minutes. Create a script/storyboard and get approved prior to filming.</p>	 <p>The graphic features a fingerprint on the left side. The word "Identity" is written in a large, outlined, sans-serif font, and the word "Theft" is written below it in a bold, solid, sans-serif font.</p>	<p>Create a QR Code Survey to give to your peers about their knowledge of identity theft. Use the results/data to create an informative Infographic using Piktochart that includes graphs and charts. Surveys must be approved prior to distributing. Will need to sign out a Chromebook.</p>
<p>Create an Interactive Board Game about identity theft & the importance of being protected. Game should be playable by 2-4 students, include all pieces and directions for how to set up/play. No Jenga. Ideas must be approved prior to constructing.</p>	<p>Write and perform for the class an original song about identity theft and the importance of protecting yourself. Think of it as a possible commercial jingle. Length/lyrics must be approved by the teacher. Musical accompaniment optional.</p>	<p>Create an informative door Bulletin Board display for the classroom or hallway, sharing information learned about identity theft and the importance of being protected. Create a rough draft for approval prior to constructing.</p>
