



Recycled Baby Rattle Project

Now that you know the benefits and important features of a baby rattle, it's your turn to create one out of recycled items. Criteria:

A. Think outside the beverage bottle! (NO beverage bottles allowed!) However, you may use other containers and materials...just be sure they meet the safety requirements. Examples you may use, but are not limited to, include:

altoid tins, candy dispensers/containers, vitamin bottles, socks, tupperware, plastic eggs, etc.

B. Sketch your ideas below before construction so you have a plan. List the materials you will need to create the rattle.

C: Evaluate your Rattle: Answer the following in complete sentences after you have completed your rattle.

Is your rattle safe? How do you know? Explain and provide evidence.

What is the age for which your rattle was designed? Explain and provide evidence?

Explain how an infant would find your rattle stimulating and fun. Be descriptive in your explanation.

Describe how your rattle would appeal to the senses. Be sure to reference specific senses in your explanation.

Explain two ways a baby would benefit from using your rattle. Refer to your notes.
