- Photos & Images--from your own photos or Google images
- Quotes--quotes or sayings that resonate with you and your content
- Logos & Slogans--logos and/or slogans of iconic brands or relevant products
- Momentos--representation of tangible or intangible items and/or products
- Characters--fictional characters or real people related to your content
- Music--add a song title or musical talent relevant to your content

- Google Slides
- Canva
